A MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

I deeply cherish the memories of my young parents beginning this journey of pouring back into the lives of inner-city Boston. I was no more than 11 years old when they started S.T.A.N.D, Inc after developing a 50-voice youth choir that transformed the hearts and minds of so many, including myself. I remember the countless conversations and the tattered napkins where vision was inscribed. I remember my late father, LeRoix Hampton III's, love for people, mentoring, and empowering the next generation of musicians to live holistically and impactfully and I have carried that spirit into my work today.

As a professional musician and college professor, I quickly saw the need for our youth to be coached, mentored, and carefully guided. The glamorous dream of becoming a professional working musician or having a career in the arts and entertainment industry is one that is the guiding torch of many of our youth today. However, many learn that achieving this goal can be extremely challenging when access to resources, education, and guided mentorship is limited. Additionally, the youth who do pursue both, higher education and careers in these industries, are often found to be ill-equipped and underprepared which results in them, quitting, being fired, or wandering, in search of purpose. It is our mission to change this narrative.

In 2021, I officially took the reigns of S.T.A.N.D Inc and launched programming in my father's hometown of Orlando, FL. In partnership with the Orlando Creative Community (The OCC), of Studio 18, we hosted a 3-day virtual and in-person workshop, production, and performance seminar for over 150 young adult creatives in the community to have a safe outlet at the peak of the COVID pandemic.

The following year, we partnered with Church on the Living Edge and their youth department to develop C.A.S.I (The Creative Arts Summer Intensive). With this five-day summer program, we were able to introduce 25 youth, ages 13-18 to five different art forms and watch them completely blossom.

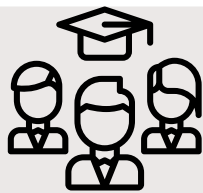

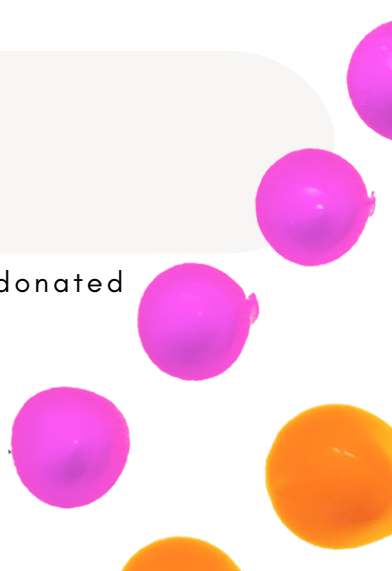

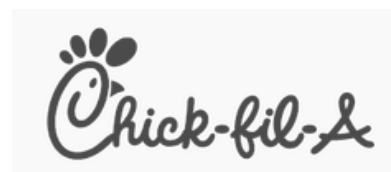
